



GT Coding in APSCN

GT coordinators report their total numbers of identified gifted and talented students as well as the demographics of that group of identified students on their Annual Gifted and Talented Program Approval Application. We check those numbers against the numbers reported in the APSCN Cycle II Report.

Please help ensure that the GT students are code correctly in APSCN by doing the following:

On Demographics Screen 102, Field 2 (GT Field), enter a “Y” in order to note that a student is identified gifted and talented. Your GT coordinator can provide you with a list of identified students for the current school year.

If students exit the program and are no longer participating, then that should be reflected in Demographics Screen 102, Field 2. The GT coordinator should let you know when students exit the program so that you can make the needed changes. It is important that this be done so that students who are not participating in the program are not included in the count of students.
